#### **TUTOR NEWS**

Congratulations to **Helen Warburton** who is taking a 12 month unpaid sabbatical as Programming and Partnerships Manager at National Trust. Helen will lead NT arts and culture programming based at the Fountains Abbey and Studley Royal UNESCO World Heritage site in North Yorkshire, taking a break from OCA role from 23/05/23 for 12 months. It's a great opportunity for Helen (and the department) to learn from her external role commissioning art and site-specific residencies. Thanks to Helen and Les Monaghan for carefully managing handover of Helen's students at stage 1.

Thanks to **Dr. Ariadne Xenou** for ongoing support at stage 3. Ariadne will be scaling back to 1 day/week from the end of June. Ariadne remains unit lead for stage 3 units. Dan as program leader will share Stage 3 management with Ariadne and we are increasing specialist tutor involvement. We are also in early stages of developing alumni involvement via group sessions.

#### Team teaching in new model

We are introducing tutor groups in some stage 1 and 2 units to help continuity of tutor support. Thanks for ongoing feedback and patience as new model systems bed in.
